

## **Cleaning and maintenance of gloss-finished furniture surfaces**

Our company has used high-quality varnish to treat the surface of your furniture. Cleaning and maintenance can therefore be managed without difficulty. However, you should be aware of a few basic aspects, the observance of which will guarantee long-term durability and elegance.

Generally speaking, furniture surfaces should only be cleaned with soft, clean and non-fuzzy cloths or a chamois. Most microfiber cloths are also suitable. To remove ground-in dust and light stains, all you need to do is dampen the cloths with water to which a small amount of standard commercially available detergent and wipe the surfaces without applying too much pressure (do not polish, do not rub!!!). Then the surface should be wiped with a dry cloth.

Standard commercially available all-purpose cleaners such as Ajax, Mr. Proper etc. and almost all washing-up liquids such as Pril, Palmolive, Fairy Ultra etc. can be used as a cleaning additive. These liquids must be used in diluted form in accordance with the directions for use described on the package.

A higher concentration of the cleaning agent may be used for stubborn stains, but never undiluted. In these cases, clear water must be applied afterwards and then wiped with a dry cloth.

Under no circumstances may scouring agents or scouring milk such as B. ATA, Viss or similar products be used. It is strongly recommended that the use aggressive bath or WC cleaners is avoided.

Polishes or care products, such as Pronto, Centralin, Polyboy, etc. are not suitable for use. These products are film-forming and dyed and should therefore not be used for treating varnish-coated surfaces.

If you adhere to these tips, you will enjoy your sparkling furniture for many years to come.
